- 1. **Public Hearing** relating to Zoning Amendment.
  - 2. Ordinance No. 632, an ordinance to amend the Zoning Ordinance of the Town of Huntingdon to revise size standards for business identification signs, second and final reading.
  - 3. Ordinance No. 633, an ordinance amending the official Zoning Ordinance of Huntingdon, Tennessee, to clarify regulations governing mobile homes / mobile home parks, first reading.
  - 4.
